Prof. Keith Vanderlinde has spent the last decade building and using telescopes to study the Universe: its composition, history, and eventual fate. Aided by the technologies that make cell phones and possible, and video games a staple of modern culture, he and colleagues from across Canada are building a massive new radio telescope named CHIME — when turned on in 2016, it will begin mapping a larger volume of space than ever attempted before, to study the mysterious Dark Energy which drives the Universe's evolution.
